

## VAT Exemption Declaration

- The VAT Act 1994 allows certain goods to be sold without VAT providing that the person buying the goods is “chronically sick or disabled”.
- A family member or health professional may purchase the goods and sign the declaration on behalf of the “chronically sick or disabled” person – eg where the goods are being purchased for a child.
- The goods purchased must be for personal or domestic use.
- Please note penalties may apply for a false declaration.
- If you are in any doubt as to whether you are eligible to receive goods or services zero-rated for VAT you should consult Notice 701/7 VAT reliefs for disabled people or contact the Inland Revenue National Advice Service on 0845 010 9000 before signing the declaration.
